Wednesday, January 29th

Afternoon departure from Barrington by private bus to Boston Logan Airport, where we board British Airways' direct service to London.

Overnight: Plane

Thursday, January 30th

Morning arrival at London Heathrow Airport, where we connect with British Airways' onward service to Nice. Our arrival at Nice Airport will be met for the transfer to our city center hotel - the Hotel West End, right on the Promenade des Anglais. The afternoon is free to unpack, relax and begin exploring the neighborhood. This evening we gather for dinner – welcome to the Cote d'Azur. **(D)**

Friday, January 31st

After breakfast, panoramic sightseeing introduces the glories of Nice: la Place Garibaldi, la Place Massena, les Boulevard des Etats-Unis. We'll end our tour at Cimiez, on the hill overlooking the city. Here we'll see the remains of the old Roman city before we head back down into the city center where a visit to the Chagall Museum is included. The afternoon and evening are free to wander through the narrow, cobbled streets of the old town or browse the Flower Market. **(B)**

Saturday, February 1st

Our excursion today begins in the town of Le Cannet, above Cannes, where we visit the new museum dedicated to the work of the painter Pierre Bonnard. After free time for lunch in nearby Cannes, we continue to Antibes for a late afternoon visit to the Picasso Museum. The evening is free to explore one of Nice's excellent restaurants or cafes. **(B)**

Sunday, February 2nd

A free day to savor Nice at your leisure, wandering streets that glow with the saturated colors of the Mediterranean. Stroll along the Promenade des Anglais, the wide, palm-lined boulevard that runs along the waterfront, and step into the lobby of the ornate Negresco—don't miss the salon royal, lit by a Baccarat chandelier made for the Czar. Or check out the Beau Rivage in Vieux Nice, where Matisse and Chekhov stayed, stop by the Matisse Museum, and explore the lively market in the old center—the Cours Saleya with its wonderful array of crystallized fruit. You could also take the train along the coast and spend the day in nearby Monaco. In the evening, we will gather to sample one of the city's many fine restaurants for our farewell dinner. **(B, D)**

Overnight: Nice

Monday, February 3rd

There may be time for a little last-minute souvenir shopping before our morning transfer to Nice Airport for our returning British Airways flights to the U.S. via London. On arrival at Boston, Logan Airport, our private bus will be waiting to take us back to Barrington. **(B)**
