I am pleased to announce that St. Peter's has arranged a small-group tour of Southeast England for next spring. We are calling it *Exploring our Anglican Roots* and it will begin in Canterbury, the seat of the Archbishop of the worldwide Anglican Communion. We will visit other sites of significant religious and historic importance, but have also included visits to beautiful gardens, the military bunkers at the White Cliffs of Dover, a winery and at least one pub! We will have time for church services and Evensong in some of the most beautiful religious structures in the world.

The tour company that we are working with, owned by a Brit, specializes in custom designed, small-group tours. At our request, they have created a tour which will help to deepen our understanding of the beginnings of Christianity in Britain, the break with Rome during the Reformation, and the progression to what is now the Church of England.

Because the tour has been created for us, the company needs plenty of advance notice to ensure that fine lodgings and other details are reserved. We will begin to accept reservations and deposits on Sunday June 19 on a first come, first served basis, for parishioners and a roommate. If we continue to have availability into August, we will consider accepting reservations from your friends or other family members. Space on the tour is limited to just 15 participants.

THURSDAY, APRIL 27TH - Evening departure from your US gateway city. **OVERNIGHT: PLANE**

FRIDAY, APRIL 28TH - Your morning arrival at London Heathrow Airport will be met for the transfer to our hotel in Canterbury. We'll break the 2-hour drive with a stop at a country pub for morning coffee or lunch (depending on the timing of your arrival) and then hopefully be able to check straight in to our hotel on arrival. After time to unpack and rest up from the overnight flight, we will gather for a tour of Canterbury Cathedral. This evening we will gather at the hotel for drinks before heading out to dinner at a local restaurant. **(D)** **OVERNIGHT: CANTERBURY**



SATURDAY, APRIL 29TH - This morning, we take a walking tour of the ancient city, rich in atmosphere and dominated by its remarkable cathedral, the final destination on the Pilgrims' Way and infamous scene of Thomas Becket's demise. We'll investigate the dramatic ruins of St. Augustine's Abbey, founded in 597; and explore the vestiges of St. Pancras church, a one-time pagan

temple. With literary allusion and inspiration all around us (let's not forget Chaucer!), we'll have a free afternoon and evening to explore the city. **(B)** **OVERNIGHT: CANTERBURY**

SUNDAY, APRIL 30TH - This morning is free to attend services at the Cathedral. Afterwards we'll take an excursion from Canterbury to the busy harbor town of Dover, Britain's gateway to the Continent, characterized by the famous White Cliffs. The starting point of the great Roman road to London, Dover has been besieged and pillaged throughout its history, and more recently during WWII endured constant shelling between 1940 and 1944. After a tour of the WWII tunnels, we'll turn our attention to the Castle, where our exploration encompasses the Pharos (remains of a 50 AD Roman lighthouse that may be the oldest standing building in England) and Henry II's splendid Keep. Returning to Canterbury, we'll stop at the Elham Valley Vineyard for a tasting of the products of The UK's booming wine industry. Dinner is included this evening at a local restaurant. **(B, D)**

OVERNIGHT: CANTERBURY

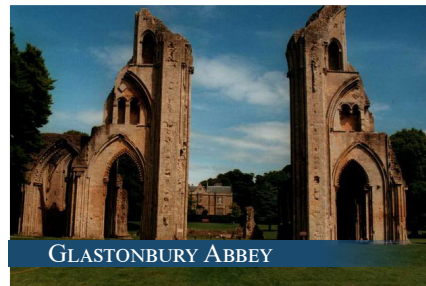
MONDAY, MAY 1ST - Leaving Canterbury and heading west this morning, our first stop will be Wisley, the showcase gardens and headquarters of the Royal Horticultural Society. We'll have a tour with one of the gardeners and then enjoy free time to have lunch, explore at your own pace, or browse the extensive gift shop and garden center. Continuing on our way, we'll make another stop this afternoon at the enigmatic World Heritage Site of Stonehenge. It is a short drive for here to our hotel in Salisbury, where dinner is included this evening. **(B, D)** **OVERNIGHT: SALISBURY**

TUESDAY, MAY 2ND - A short drive this morning brings us to Mottisfont Abbey. Originally a C12th Augustinian Priory, this wonderful estate is now the home of the National Collection of Old-fashioned Roses. We'll tour the garden and have lunch before returning to Salisbury for a free afternoon. Stroll the lovely medieval streets, visit the Antiques Center on Catherine Street, check out one of the four remaining originals of the Magna Carta, or walk to the Old Mill for a glorious view of the cathedral. You may wish to experience choral evensong at the cathedral. This evening, you're free to try a local restaurant. **(B)** **OVERNIGHT: SALISBURY**



WEDNESDAY, MAY 3RD - Leaving Salisbury, a short drive brings us to the village of Stourton, where we'll walk around the magnificent Stourhead Gardens, which surround a series of peaceful lakes in the middle of a 2,650-acre estate nestled among rolling hills. And the rhododendron should be in full bloom! From here we drive into the beautiful the city of Bath, stopping along the way to visit the spectacularly well-preserved Saxon church at Bradford-upon-Avon. After checking into our hotel in Bath, we'll take a walking tour of the city center and will visit the Roman Baths, perhaps the best-preserved Roman remains in Britain. We'll dine together at our hotel. **(B, D)**

OVERNIGHT: BATH



GLASTONBURY ABBEY

THURSDAY, MAY 4TH - Our excursion from Bath today takes us to Britain's other important pilgrimage destination. We'll tour the ruins of

Glastonbury Abbey, see the graves of King Arthur and Queen Guinevere, and the Glastonbury Thorn. This tree is said to be 2000 years old and sprang from the staff of Joseph of Arimathea when he brought the Holy Grail here after the crucifixion. Continuing on through the Vale of Avalon, we'll visit Wells, the smallest city in the country and home to Wells Cathedral and the adjoining Bishop's Palace. We'll return to Bath for a free evening. **(B)** **OVERNIGHT: BATH**

FRIDAY, MAY 5TH - Avoiding the motorway, we'll wend our way back east today ending in the town of Royal Windsor. On the way we'll pay a visit to the village of Avebury, a center of prehistoric activity. Surrounded by long barrows and the mysterious Silbury Hill, the Neolithic stone circle here is so large that the village is actually inside it! We will arrive at our hotel in Windsor with time to visit the Castle. A farewell dinner tonight at our hotel. **(B, D)**

OVERNIGHT: WINDSOR

SATURDAY, MAY 6TH- Morning transfer to nearby Heathrow Airport for the returning flight to the U.S. If, however, you

are not quite ready to go home yet, why not contact Discover Europe and ask about arranging to stay on in London for a few days. **(B)**

GENERAL

1. Please be sure to complete both sides of this form.

3. Space on this journey is limited and registrations are accepted strictly on a first come, first served basis.
4. Registration and payment imply acceptance of the terms and conditions described herein. This information, as well as your itinerary description regarding dates, inclusions and prices, form the basis of your individual contract with Discover Europe, Ltd.
5. Registration and payment waive and release Discover Europe, Ltd., their affiliates, directors, officers, employees, including any person or entity employed or utilized by them, from all claims arising from any injury, loss, damage, accident, delay or expense resulting from events beyond their control, including, without limitation: natural disasters, war, strikes, incidents of politically-motivated violence, sickness or quarantine, government restrictions or regulations, and in the absence of its own gross negligence, arising from the use of any vehicle or from any act of omission by any bus or car rental agency, airline, taxi or tour service, hotel, restaurant, or other firm, agency, company or individual.
6. Discover Europe, Ltd. reserves the right to substitute hotels, airlines, activities or excursions in response to changes in availability, local events or weather conditions, provided such substitutions do not adversely affect the overall quality of the tour. Such substitutions do not constitute grounds for withdrawal with full refund.
7. Conduct During the Tour: You are also responsible for respecting the authority and following the directions of the tour guide and the laws of the countries in your itinerary. We may exclude you from participating in all or any part of the tour if, in our sole discretion, your condition or behavior renders you unfit for the tour or unfit for continuation once the tour has begun. Unfitness may include, without limitation, any behavior that, regardless of its cause, is inappropriate or offensive or interferes with the delivery of tour services, or may constitute a hazard or embarrassment. In such case, our liability shall be strictly limited to refund of the recoverable cost of any unused portion of the tour. Should you decide not to participate in certain parts of the tour or use certain goods included in the tour, no refunds will be made for those unused parts of the tour or goods.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE

1. A deposit of \$500 must accompany this completed form.
2. The remaining balance will be billed and payable 90 days prior to trip departure.

TOUR COST ADJUSTMENTS

Discover Europe makes every effort to guarantee that the published cost of your chosen tour will not change. However we do reserve the right to make adjustments in the following circumstances:

1. Exchange rates. Should the value of the dollar fall against the currency of the countries visited on your tour by more than 10% in the 6 months prior to trip departure.
2. Group size. This tour has been based on a group size of 12-15 participants. Should we end up with less than 12 people, Discover Europe will work with to determine a course of action which will involve either paying a surcharge to keep the tour as is, or making adjustments to the tour in order to keep the cost the same.
3. Airfares. If your tour includes airfare, Discover Europe reserves the right to pass along increases in costs (taxes, airport fees, fuel surcharges, etc.) that are charged by the airline involved.

REFUND POLICY

1. Participants who withdraw more than 90 days prior to tour departure will receive a refund of all monies received by Discover Europe, Ltd., less a \$200 cancellation penalty.
2. Participants who withdraw less than 90 days and more than 60 days prior to tour departure will receive a refund of all monies received by Discover Europe, Ltd., less a \$1000 cancellation penalty.
3. Participants who withdraw less than 60 days prior to the day of tour departure will not receive a refund unless they have purchased travel insurance.
4. Trip cancellation insurance is not included in your Discover Europe tour package. Discover Europe, Ltd., strongly advises that you purchase travel insurance for your upcoming trip. Discover Europe will be happy to provide information describing the services of a recommended insurance company, which will fully detail the coverages, provisions, limitations, and exclusions of the insurance offered.
5. All cancellation requests must be received in writing. There is no provision for refund for any activities missed due to the participant's absence once the tour has started.
