DETAILED INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Passenger Details:

- i). Name(s). Please make sure that your name appears on this form exactly as it does on your passport.
- ii). Address. If you have a different summer address, please give the details, including dates that you are there, on a separate sheet.
- iii). Passport Details. Having your passport details ahead of time enables Discover Europe to speed the check-in process at hotels and helps in the event of lost or stolen documents.
- iv). Dietary Requirements. Please let us know if you require any special meals both for the hotels and the airlines.

The Guggenheim, Bilbao

We begin in Barcelona, possibly Spain's most visually striking city. As Rose Macaulay wrote four decades ago, "...it gives an impression of tempestuous, surging, irrepressible life and *brio*." We'll spend our days exploring the *Barri Gotic*, the very heart of Barcelona, her outstanding museums and architecture.

Our second port of call, Bilbao, is a city which was virtually unknown until the opening of the magnificent Guggenheim Museum in 1987. This modern masterpiece, with its unique, titanium-clad walls, was designed by the American architect, Frank Gehry. Now the city is bursting with new development, superb restaurants and a cheerful welcome. We'll spend an entire day at the Guggenheim and its older neighbor, the Museo de Bellas Artes.

And finally, we will have a stay in the capital, Madrid. We'll visit her museums, take an excursion or two and still have time to sit and share *tapas* with the *Madrilenos*. This spring join the Newport Art Museum and Discover Europe on an unforgettable European adventure to experience the beauty, art and culture that is irresistible Spain.

Saturday, May 1st Overnight: Plane

This afternoon you gather at the Newport Art Museum to take a private bus to New York's JFK Airport, where you board your overnight Iberia flight to Spain.

Sunday, May 2nd Overnight: Barcelona

We will stop briefly this morning in Madrid before continuing on to Barcelona. Your courier will meet you at the airport and it's a short coach journey to our city center hotel. There will be time to unpack, rest from the flights and have lunch before we gather for our first visit, the Museu Picasso. Housed in a magnificent medieval palace, this is certainly one of the most important collections of Picasso's work in the world. An early-evening welcome dinner at the hotel rounds off a memorable first day. **(D)**

Monday, May 3rd Overnight: Barcelona

This morning we board our bus for a panoramic sightseeing tour of this vibrant and cosmopolitan city.

From the Old City to the ancient harbor, from the chic

commercial center - the "Eixample" - to the city's world-famous museums, this city is endlessly fascinating. We'll pass by some of Gaudi's greatest buildings and explore the Port Olympic and Olympic Village, built for the 1992 Games. The afternoon is free to explore the Barri Gotic, its cathedral, and its medieval streets and churches. The evening is free to sample a traditional Catalonian restaurant. **(B)**

Tuesday, May 4th Overnight: Barcelona

Today we spend on Montjuic, visiting its remarkable museums. The Museu Nacional d' Art de Catalunya has a splendid collection of medieval paintings, Romanesque frescoes that have been painstakingly removed from village churches and restored, and some of the finest examples of Renaissance and Baroque art. A short walk brings us to the Poble Espanyol, or "Spanish Village," which was designed for the International Exhibition and chronicles the development of Spanish vernacular architecture. We'll conclude at the Fundacio Joan Miro, which displays the work of Miro from 1914-1978. This evening we gather for a final dinner in a local restaurant. **(B, D)**

Wednesday, May 5th Overnight: Bilbao

Morning transfer to Barcelona Airport for our internal flight to Bilbao. After checking into our hotel, an afternoon panoramic tour of the city, from the city's old quarter to the spectacular views enjoyed on the Artxanda funicular. This evening we gather for dinner at the hotel. **(B, D)**

Thursday, May 6th Overnight: Bilbao

Today the Guggenheim, probably the most talked-about museum in recent years. Our ticket is valid for the entire day and after a guided tour of the museum's highlights, we will break for lunch. This afternoon is free for individual exploration or you can visit the nearby Museu de Bellas Artes, now overshadowed by its world-famous neighbor, but with a fine collection of El Greco, Goya, Van Dyck and the Basque artists. The evening is free. **(B)**

Friday, May 7th Overnight: Madrid

This morning we transfer to Bilbao Airport for the short flight to the capital. On arrival we are met by our coach and driven straight south to the city of Toledo. There will be time for lunch before our local guide takes us through the cathedral, the tiny church of Santo Tome to view El Greco's huge painting *The Burial of the Count of Orgaz*, and the graceful and simple Synagogue del Transito. We return to Madrid to check in to our hotel, where dinner is included this evening. **(B, D)**

Saturday, May 8th Overnight: Madrid

A panoramic sightseeing tour of Madrid this morning will conclude at the Paseo del Arte, the Art Walk, a rejuvenated route joining Madrid's three largest art galleries, the Prado, the Reina Sofia and the Thyssen-Bornemisza. Each one is preparing to unveil new wings over the coming year. Our local guide will give us an introduction to the masterpieces on display at the Prado and then there will be free time for lunch and those who so desire can continue on the Art Walk in the afternoon. This evening why not sample a few tapas bars - your courier will have plenty of suggestions. **(B)**



El Escorial

Sunday, May 9th Overnight: Madrid

Today we make a full day excursion to some of the most spectacular sights in Spain just outside Madrid. We'll begin at El Escorial, the massive palace built for Philip II. We continue to the Valley of the Fallen, a monument to those who died in the Spanish Civil War. The elegant city of Segovia is our final visit; we'll see its famous Roman aqueduct before free time to explore. Upon our return to Madrid, we'll have a farewell dinner at a neighborhood restaurant. **(B, D)**

Monday, May 10th Overnight: Home

This morning we transfer to the airport for our direct flight back to New York. Here your private bus will be waiting to take you back to Newport. **(B)**
