Travel to England with the Medieval Academy of America to see two once-in-a-lifetime exhibitions, "Anglo-Saxon Kingdoms" at the British Library in London and "Tolkien: Maker of Middle Earth" at Oxford University's Bodleian Library. These exhibits together will allow visitors to view, on the one hand, some of the most beautiful and important books of the early Middle Ages (including the Beowulf manuscript) and, on the other, peer into the mind of one of the great fantasy writers of the twentieth century, whose work was inspired by his own scholarship in the field of Old English. Participants will be treated to curator-led presentations and will be accompanied by Lisa Fagin Davis, Executive Director of the Medieval Academy of America.

Tuesday, October 23RD - Departure from your chosen US gateway city. **Overnight: Plane**


Wednesday, October 24TH - Your morning arrival at London Heathrow Airport will be met for the transfer to our city-center hotel. After time to unpack and rest up from the overnight flight, there will be time to unpack, relax and begin exploring the neigh-

borhood. This evening we will gather for a cocktail reception and dinner at the hotel. **(D) Overnight: London**

Thursday, October 25TH - This morning we will visit the British Library, just along the road from our hotel. We will have a reception and introduction from the curator and then a tour of the *Anglo-Saxon Kingdoms* exhibition led by Lisa Fagin Davis. The afternoon is free for individual exploration until we meet again for an early supper before attending a West End theatre performance (Sir Ian McKellan as King Lear at the Duke of York's Theatre). **(B, D) Overnight: London**

Friday, October 26TH - Leaving London this morning, we head for Oxford, the "City of Dreaming Spires." On arrival, we will check in to our hotel and then have free time for lunch. This afternoon we'll visit the Bodleian Library to view the *Tolkien: Maker of Middle Earth* exhibition. We'll have a curatorial introduction and then tour the exhibition. Dinner is included at a local restaurant this evening. **(B, D) Overnight: Oxford**






Saturday, October 27TH - A walking tour this morning of the beautiful city of Oxford, astride the River Thames, its historic buildings clustered within easy walking distance around the medieval core. The real treasure is the architectural beauty of Oxford University and its diverse buildings, many of which date back to the 13th and 14th centuries. We'll end our tour with a visit to Christchurch, the largest of the Oxford colleges. After free time for lunch, we'll return to London, where we'll again have free time before gathering for a farewell dinner. **(B, D) Overnight: London**

Sunday, October 28th - You may have time this morning for a little last-minute shopping before your transfer back to Heathrow Airport for returning flights to the U.S. **(B) Overnight: Home**



- 1. Exchange rates. Should the value of the dollar fall against the British Pound by more than 10% in the 6 months prior to trip departure.
- 2. Group size. This tour has been based on a group size of 10-15 participants. Should we end up with fewer than 15 people, Discover Europe will work with Medieval Academy of America to determine a course of action which will involve either paying a surcharge to keep the tour as is, or making adjustments to the tour in order to keep the cost the same.
- 3. Airfares. If your tour includes airfare, Discover Europe reserves the right to pass along increases in costs (taxes, airport fees, fuel surcharges, etc.) that are charged by the airline involved.

REFUND POLICY
